What one hears is a performance by a grown-up individual and a person. It is a special pleasure for me to commend the art of her remarkable music teacher, Mira Marchenko. Yet there are things that cannot be taught and learned. Alexandra Dovgan's talent is exceptionally harmonious. Her playing is honest and concentrated. I predict a great future for her..."
